



1 Connect to a Computer

a. Unplug the power cable and remove the case panel.




b. Locate an available PCI-E slot and carefully insert the adapter.


Note:
If the bracket is not suitable for your computer, detach it from the adapter's board and replace it with the low-profile bracket provided.



c. Connect the antennas to the adapter.



d. Replace the case panel, plug in the power cable and turn on your computer.



2 Install Driver

- a. Insert the CD and run the **Autorun.exe**.




If you can't install the driver successfully, disable the antivirus software and firewall, then try again.
